


Septic Tank Compartment Divider Installation Instructions

Be certain to consult with the applicable governing agency regarding the divider location and fitting requirements for your tank. Failure to heed may result in an illegal installation.

CAUTION: INSTALLATION OF THIS KIT IS INTENDED TO BE PERFORMED WITH TANK ABOVE GROUND AND WITHOUT SOIL PRESSURE ON WALLS.

To Install Divider panels:

- 1. Insert the two Outer Divider Panels (Part Number 10157) through nearest manway to final location. There is no front or back to the panels as they are reversible. Position panels into the applicable tank wall rib groove on both sides of tank. It may help to temporarily hold panels apart with a 9-1/2" long 2" x 2" wood block.
- 2. Insert Center Divider Panel (Part Number 10158) through manway aligning grooves on Center Panel with tongues on outer panels. Center Panel will require some force to fully seat it fully down between outer panels.
- 3. Drill a 13/32" diameter hole through the tongue and groove joint at one top corner of the Center Panel. Install a 3/8" x 4" hex bolt and hex nut through hole to lock Center Panel into place.
- 4. The Center Divider Panel can be drilled as required for holes or fittings according to your code requirements.
